- Korin in process of obtaining bookkeeping for audit for AGM
- Budget - \$4155.04
- \$10,000 from PTANT on its way
- Next AENT meeting – the AGM will be held at the Groove Café Tuesday 31st March 4pm
- AENT will check out the recycling art makers while before and during this meeting
- No interest in the AAANZ in Darwin due to the December timing, not great for teachers due to the timing of the event.
- MCA survey is for individuals – Marianne will forward to members
- members Annual Art exhibition opening to be held either 4th or 11th September at the Botanical Gardens Venue. Details and set date TBA.
- There was interest in the Mens shed to make plinths, Sam to research. Veronica offered storage and there is also PTANT storage. Making, painting and storage of plinths was discussed.
- Interest in contacting Jasmin Jan for some PD's relating to botanical art which may be the theme for this years Art Exhibition. Veronica to advise
- Big interest in the CDU Intensive courses on offer: there was discussion on AENT members receiving discount – it was decided to subsidise half the cost of a workshop (\$200) for up to 12 members.

- Kate Murphy has also advised that virtual exhibitions through the NGA will be commencing soon, via Skype.
