## President's Report 2022

Another wonderful year of the AENT!

The year started off celebrating the collaborative efforts of all Art Teachers and students through Exit Art at MAGNT. The AENT prize was given to Emma King from Marrara Christian College, who created two beautiful works that depicted her and her family.

The annual exhibition 'Nurture' was next up, opening on the 8th of April at DVA, bringing together many artists sharing work. Hosting the exhibition with Alison Worsnop was a highlight and having Ali Copely to open the show. We enjoyed a Silverpoint workshop with Alison in the gallery space which was wonderful and traced back through the history of art to understand the origins of drawing!

Korin and Lucy ran a Curriculum Development PD at Durack Arts space, with Robyn Carmody and Kylie Nagle and guest speakers. This was an opportunity for teachers across primary and secondary classrooms to work together on aligning with the Australian Curriculum and SACE standards/requirements.
